<p><u>School Sports Partnership SLA – Leisure Works Basic Level</u></p> <p>Access to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A full organised annual programme of competitions/tournaments/festivals in addition to the National School Games. • Participation, inclusion and excellence opportunities • The gifted & talented Leisureworks Dance Academy Pupils identified by our Community Dance Activator will be invited to attend a gifted and talented Dance Academy which rehearses throughout the year culminating in a performance at the annual Sports and Physical Activity Awards. • CPD for curriculum physical education (e.g. twilights, PD days (choice from an annual menu), NQT support, team teaching, mentoring) • Provision of 5 week blocks of curriculum and/or after-school activity in a variety of sports each half term. As a guide these are likely to include; <i>Multi-skills, Dance, Gymnastics, Basketball, Athletics & Tennis</i> • SSP Network meetings to support PE Co-ordinators in their role developing PE & sport within school • Promotion and development of links to local sports clubs • Central co-ordination of school sport programmes in SSP area • Leadership: Leisureworks Young Leaders Training Opportunity for a group of Year 5/6 pupils in each school to train as young leaders to use within your own school (e.g. as PE monitors/Playground buddies). • Transport to sporting events / swimming sessions 	<p>£3000</p> <p>£2500</p>
<p><u>School Sports Partnership – Bolt On</u></p> <p>Access to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30 hours of high quality teaching support - The SSP will co-ordinate qualified teachers to support schools in teaching High Quality Curriculum PE. The support will include team teaching, curriculum planning support and/or whole school CPD sessions. At Burnhope Primary School all teachers will have access to upskilling from EYFS through to Year 6 • Menu of CPD Opportunities – an extensive calendar of training opportunities, delivered by experts as identified by primary schools • Links to NGBs/Community Clubs – The SSP will ensure that any coaching schools receive will link with wider opportunities available in the community for young people to continue their involvement in sport. 	<p>£1500</p>
