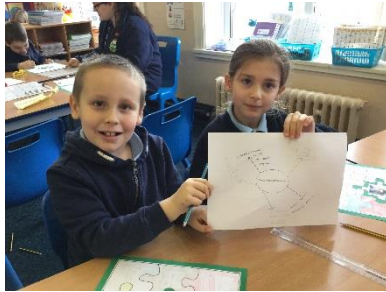




Class Three Spring Newsletter
