## Absences

You **MUST** telephone the school office 01207 520 243 to report a school absence.

If it is COVID related we need to know if they are symptomatic, awaiting a test or a test result. If anyone else in the household takes a COVID test, the rest of the household **MUST** isolate immediately until the test result is received. It is **REALLY** important that you share this information with us as soon as possible.



If you or your child develop any of the following symptoms you **MUST** arrange a COVID-19 test.

- **a high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back or have a temperature of more than 37.8 degrees Celsius
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different from normal
