

Over the Summer Term we are focussing on the topic, 'It's a Wonderful World moving onto The Great Outdoors'. We will be reading many books around nature and will start our topic with The Very Busy Spider. These are overarching themes and we will also plan within our provision as much as possible around your child's interests. If there is anything that is making your child buzz with enthusiasm at the moment, let us know. The children were delighted to see the butterflies had emerged from the chrysalides.

Your child will continue to receive their homework on a Thursday. In there you will find their 'My World Book'; this is an opportunity for you to share your experiences of what you and your child have been involved in at home. The book has been extremely successful in the past and the children love to share what they have been up to at home. You can draw in it, write in it or put some photos in it. It just allows a real connection between home and school. In addition to this, the Reception children will receive a reading book which follows our RWI scheme. Children will also receive a library book. Please return these weekly as this helps the staff to rotate the books and change them regularly.

Please send your child into school daily with a water bottle. This will be returned at the end of each day.

We will be having PE every Wednesday and have asked if the children can come to school dressed for PE.

Please remember not to send a school bag in, we will put all letters and information in their homework organiser.
