<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection. • Maintain high levels of health, hygiene and safety through rigorous and regular cleaning, following government guidance. • Provide a learning environment that meets the needs of your child’s wellbeing, mental health and academic needs to the best of our ability, either in person or remotely. • Celebrate your child’s academic and personal achievements. • Provide the support needed to enable your child to achieve their full potential. • Care for your child’s safety and wellbeing by observation and listening to them. • Support your child to develop a positive attitude to one another, regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values, age and need. • Regularly meet with you either in person or remotely to communicate the progress of your child • Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19. • Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Respect and Positive Relationships Policy as well the expectations in this agreement. • Communicate between home and school through either text service, Class Dojo, email and the school website. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone or email the outcome of that test and liaise with track and trace. • When dropping off and picking up, I will stick to the school timings and ensure my child is on time. • My child must not bring any items into school with them other than the items agreed by school or take items home from school. • Any important item that my child needs to bring to school with them e.g. a mobile phone for walking home alone, will be communicated to staff in advance and the device will be handed into the class teacher at the gate to be stored securely for the day then handed back to children as they are dismissed (Key Stage 2 only). • Any smart watches worn by children must have notifications disabled on them for the duration of the child’s time in school otherwise they risk being confiscated. Any smart watches with in-built cameras <u>are not</u> permitted under any circumstance and will be confiscated. • I understand if I need to come into school to speak to staff I will need to make an appointment and all contact will be via telephone or email unless I have an appointment.. • I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an ‘as safe as possible’ environment for my child. • I will read all messages/emails that are sent home. • I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carer and emergency contacts details. • I will let the school know of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child’s learning or behaviour, as this can then be resolved quickly. • I will attend meetings either in person or remotely with my child’s teacher and other staff, aiming to be positive and productive, working towards moving my child on in their learning or emotional wellbeing. • I will support and work with school to ensure that the behaviour management policies are maintained, particularly with my child. • I will always uphold the school’s ethos of respect towards everyone. • I will encourage a positive attitude towards my child’s education and our school. If I have any concerns, I will contact and discuss them with staff as it is much healthier to work out solutions and move on. • I will support my child with any homework or remote learning sent home to the best of my ability engaging with school in relation to any issues. • I will talk to my child about staying safe online and monitor their internet use during any remote learning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adhere to the social distancing rules in class. • Tell an adult if I feel unwell. • Not bring things into school from home that have not been agreed by school or take things home from school unless permission has been granted. • Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (Catch It-Bin It-Kill It). • Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitizer. • Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others. • Respect other children’s culture, race, feelings, beliefs and values. • Accept responsibility for the things that I do. • Be responsible for my school and remote learning work. • Ask for help if I need it and try my best in all that I do. • When remote learning, I will work hard to complete work sent home. • I will follow our school’s Respect and Positive Relationships Policy at all times when in school or remote learning. • I will be kind and speak politely to everyone in school. • I will take good care of the building, equipment and school grounds. • I will tell a member of staff if I am worried or unhappy or use the Worry Monster in class. • I will always check with an adult before using the internet both at home and in school. • I will tell a grown up if I see something online that worries me. • I will only communicate politely with others online. • I will keep my personal information, my name, my address, my pictures and videos ‘Top Secret’ (private) and not share them on an app or website knowing that the majority of sites are not suitable for those aged under 12. • I will not share my passwords with anyone else, nor will I log in using someone else’s account. <p>Mainly appropriate for KS2:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I am aware of ‘stranger danger’ when online and will not arrange to meet online friends. • I will not try to bypass systems in place to reach websites or apps that the school has blocked. • I understand that the school may check my files and monitor the web pages I visit. • When in school or remote working, I will only contact people with my teacher’s permission using the online platforms shared with us. • I will not attempt to install software on school computers. • I will not use the school system for gaming, gambling, shopping, uploading videos, pictures or music.
